## **OPI Chair and Vice Chair Update**

If summer 2024 will be remembered in Ontario's energy circles, it will be low gas prices, medium oil prices and a high level of political activity readying for a premature provincial spring election!

Opportunity abounds.

This has been a year of successful regulatory activity as we participated together with our renewable fuels cousins in an Enbridge hearing to expose barriers to connections and unexplained weak gas purchase pricing. Several years ago, the Ontario Energy Board demonstrated courage and pulled back the veil on gas pricing, only to discover that its jurisdiction is lacking, and it could do nothing. Except that, the Board declared that it could take jurisdiction on connections and the procedures that had impaired local producers' ability to get their gas to market. We hope that the years ahead will show that persistence, transparency and competence pay off as Ontario benefits from a healthier local energy sector, fresh leadership and invigorated fossil interests taking a look at opportunities in the renewable energy sector. That surveillance of renewable and related energy interests has started to bolster our association's membership and hits on our sites from nearby and away. For those considering hydrogen production to storage, and compressed air to carbon sequestration, the field is opening to new developments, taking our industry in some ways into a full circle. It is this new demand for archived information, which our industry has smartly preserved in our OGSR Library, with our highly competent staff, that is driving, in part, the political reactions and furor of activities at Queens Park. Energy is becoming a crunch issue at the fossil, emissions and power sectors, concurrently.

Just ask the politicos who recently ventured into the field of public inquiry to take the pulse on how the public feels at the carbon sequestration roundtable, which met with some serious local farmer skepticism, maybe cynicism. Together with our government confreres, OPI members have discovered they have the ability to make a difference in moving public opinion and assisting our elected members in making good, informed decisions. The hope is this allegiance (if not unholy

alliance) will bear some fruit all around as the fall legislative provisions dealing with bedrock energy issues reach the floor of the house.

OPI can be proud of its long history in dealing with these types of emerging issues, technologies and positive prospects for new business. With the IESO calling for 6000 MW of hydrogen power generation worth billions to replace new and aging natural gas plants, our members have the expertise to facilitate the transition and find the appropriate partners to participate in parts of that power market. Similarly, with compressed air energy storage, which boasts a near 70% round trip efficiency, our new Porous Rock Regulation should be tweaked to allow for a few hundreds-to-thousands of MWs of essential VAR power balancing as the renewable fleet grows in a sector poised to grow from 22000 MW to over 80000 MW in a quarter century, a feat never previously planned nor achieved.

Your keen interest and support will be a worthwhile investment of time and effort for future generations. Governments sometimes operate in vacuums, but not for long. The recent set of workshops, meetings and collaborations are starting to pay off. Our Membership enjoys respect and an interactive capability with the MNRF, which should be advanced better and harder as the term of this government unfolds. More new legislation is needed, and mistakes need to be corrected to ensure market conditions are understood and implemented. We can contemplate more outreach and reap the benefits of investment in theses interactions, even with those who may not share all our OPI perspectives - yet.

Your OPI board is all ears to your suggestions and commentary. Please keep us in mind when you discover an issue that requires a sensible resolution, such as our historical producers raised and successfully resolved.

Enjoy a safe and successful summer as we prepare for a vigorous autumn!
